Purpose of the Trip:

MMI brings short-term medical teams to small communities with little access to health care. Each patient receives free medical attention and an opportunity to hear the Gospel explained by a national believer. MMI also brings non-medical people to help on construction projects. Construction teams work directly with church volunteers and follow their lead on a project they want to accomplish.

- ✚ The release of the medication duffels from the airport officials without any delay
- ✚ A servant's heart for each team member
- ✚ Health and safety for the team members as well as their families who remain behind
- ✚ Open hearts of the people we serve to receive the "good news"
- ✚ The courage of each team member to witness and share when the opportunity presents itself either in Mali or here in the US
- ✚ Agreement, understanding, grace and forgiveness between the leaders of the national team and ourselves as we work together daily
- ✚ A listening ear to hear the Lord speaking and then the desire to carry out His will
