MAIN IDEAS

- Noah's descendants journeyed east and settled in the land of Shinar.
- They decided to build a tower to the heavens with brick and mortar.
- They wanted to make a name for themselves.

Which of Noah's sons were the descendents in Babel according to Genesis 10:6-11?

How did the LORD confuse the tower builders? Why?

How does God react to pride according to Luke 14:11?

What is the reason God reacts this way according to Exodus 20:4-5?

How can praying Psalm 139:23-24 combat pride?

PERSONAL RESPONSE

Think of a time when you've experienced the LORD'S humbling. Proverbs 11:2, Proverbs 15:33, Proverbs 18:12.

How did He deal with you?

How did you respond?

What did you learn? Isaiah 57:15.

Are you open to the LORD'S correction in our lives in the area of pride? Psalm 32:8-9.

Pray that the LORD would reveal all the areas of pride in your life.

Meditate on Psalm 139:23-24 this week.
